## **Recent Events**

**2023 Sept 15 to 17 in Kyoto:** IAF SEMINAR FOR YOUNG ADULTS (1st time seminar for 18-25 1st through 3rd Dan. Part of the seminar was be taught by Doshu.) More than 200 Young Adults from 14 country members of the IAF were present - France, Guam, USA, the Netherlands, Belgium, Hong Kong, Australia, Romania, Poland, Norway, South Africa, India, Azerbaijan and Japan.

- ➤ 2023 October 24 to 25 in Riyadh: WCG (World Combat Games): This martial arts event is designed to encourage youth participation in martial arts as well as community involvement. The IAF is a main participant in this event. Saudi Arabia has put together the a promo video.
- ➤ Japan's Cultural Grant Assistance gave 200 tatamis to the Algerian Aikido Federation.
